Examples for Name-Splitting Macros

These macros are designed to copy a string of names from a bibliography, invert the name order if needed, and split them up into individual entries in your indexing program. *They do not cover every possible bibliographic format, only the ones that have been requested so far.*

Section I: String of Names *in Normal Name Order*

All four of the following patterns use the same keyboard shortcuts:
